# Studying with us

#### **FUNDING OPTIONS**

#### **Smart and Skilled**

Under Smart and Skilled the NSW Government contributes to the cost of each course with the student paying the balance. To be eligible for Smart and Skilled Funding you must be:

- 15 years old or over; and
- · no longer at school; and
- living or working in NSW (or an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person living in specific NSW border areas); and
- an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, Australian permanent humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen; or
- a NSW apprentice or trainee.

#### **Community Service Obligation**

Funding under Smart & Skilled is provided by the NSW Government to assist learners who need extra support or assistance to access training.

#### Eligible learners include:

- people who are unemployed or underemployed






