FUNDING OPTIONS

Smart and Skilled

- an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, Australian permanent humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen; or
- a NSW apprentice or trainee.



It is nationally recognised for 5 years and enables the holder to legally use restricted chemicals unsupervised.

Chemical user re-accreditation course needs to be completed before the current ticket expires. **Refreshers** only attend the second day of this two-day Chemical Users course.

Prerequisites for re-accreditation: Participants must hold a current Chemical User qualification that has not expired and bring this to be sighted by the trainer on the day of the course.
