



Community College Award Proposal

Proposal

Community College Northern Inland Inc. (CCNI) will offer an award to a senior student, enrolled in Year 11 or 12 at secondary school during 2019.

Award Purpose

To make a contribution towards the cost of further vocational or work-related education in the year after the winning student completes high school (or in the case of a Year 11 recipient it may be used while they are studying Year 12). The offer is only valid for 12 months after winning the award (or in the case of a Year 11 student winning the Award it can be negotiated to 24 months).

The course selected, to which this money can be directed, may be:

- the long term vocational choice of the student; or
- a preparatory or bridging course towards the long term vocational choice; or
- complementary to their long term vocational choice; or
- a short course which may help gain part-time employment while the student undertakes their vocational training.

Award Value

The Award value is \$200 per school. Payment will be made on presentation of receipts or an invoice from an education provider, such as university, TAFE or Community College, by the recipient of the Award.

Eligibility

The student who wins this Award will have demonstrated an ongoing and active interest in learning. They will not necessarily be the most academic or have achieved high marks in their school work, however, they will have consistently tried and shown a commitment to learn and succeed and have clear goals for their future.

Award Promotion

Each of the secondary schools is asked to inform the students and school community of the availability of the Award, its purpose and value during the year through the school newsletter, college brochure, or local media.

Selection Process

Each school is responsible for selection of the recipient. The name of the recipient must be communicated to the College Campus Coordinator at least one week prior to the Awards ceremony.

Presentation

A requirement of the Award is that the local College Campus Coordinator must be invited to present the Award to the recipient at the Awards ceremony.
